Synopsis

Reports the data that are associated with a curve.

Syntax

```
chips> [D #] [C #] TYPE

where D # is a drawing area number designation and C # is a curve number designation.
```

Two curves are plotted in drawing area 1. The TYPE command reports the data that are associated with curve number 1.
