The newest version of the Chandra Interactive Analysis of Observations software, is <u>CIAO 4.1</u>, released on 15 December 2008. Read the <u>release notes</u> for detailed information. This release requires that <u>CALDB 4.1.0</u> be installed for the software to work correctly.
